100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1500m, 5000m, 10000m, 100mH, 400mH, 3000mSC, High Jump, Pole Vault, Long Jump, Triple Jump, Shot Put, Discus Throw, Javelin Throw
4. Eligibility Deaf, defined as a hearing loss of at least 55 dB in better ear.
5. Limited Participation
It is the presentation to a person in charge of contestant by the presentation by the email and the competition day, a call start to the association of hearing person with a disability track and field secretariat by June 7: on the competition day before.

7. Prize-Giving
First place finishers in both men's and women's events will receive a trophy and a medal and certificate of merit. Second and third place finishers will receive a medal and certificate of merit. However, in events with two participants, only the first place finisher will receive prizes (in this

case both a trophy and a medal and certificate of merit), and in events with three participants, only the first and second place finishers will receive prizes (first place finisher will receive both a trophy and a medal and certificate of merit and second place finisher will receive a medal and certificate of merit).

8. Entry Fee

(We do not take entry fee for foreign players this games. But, your accommodation and travel expenses, food expenses must be paid by yourself.)

General player entry for each event	5,000 yen
University player entry for each event	3,000 yen
High school player entry for each event	800 yen

10. Athletic Equipment

All athletes shall use the equipment provided by the event sponsor, with the exception of pole-vault poles.

- (1) A 2.00 kg discus is used in the Men's Discus Throw and a 1.00 kg discus is used in the Women's Shot Put.
- (2) A 2.00 kg discus is used in the Men's Discus Throw and a 1.00 kg discus is used in the Women's Discus Throw.
- (3) An 800 g javelin is used in the Men's Javelin Throw and a 600 g javelin is used in the Women's Javelin Throw.

11. Personal information handling

The organizers and the manager deal with the personal information, by complying with laws and regulations related to the protection of personal information and with the Act on the Protection of Personal Information. Moreover, the personal information which has been obtained will be used for making the necessary contacts related to the operation of tournaments and the track-and-field events, including such matters as the compilation and the creation of the examination program in the tournament qualifications, record announcement and official homepage, etc.

12. Other

- (1) The length of the spike, the track uses 9mm or less and the field uses 12mm or less.
- (2) Number card will prepare by the organizer.
- (3) This competition will use the light stimulus start system for the short distance event and hurdles event.
- (4) About Uniforms
Each participating member federation must wear the team uniforms.
- (5) The organizer will perform the emergency measures for any injuries and sickness during the competition only.
- (6) The video of the competition prohibits that a third party uses this without permission of the organizer and the sponsors. (Don't deliver the pictures and videos on the Internet.)
